

Announcement on Concealment, Non-Declaration, and Incorrect Declaration of Dangerous Goods

Concerning Customers' Concealment, Non-Declaration, and Incorrect Declaration of Dangerous Goods

Dear Valued Customers,

In view of the serious consequences and potential significant economic losses arising from the concealment, non-declaration, and incorrect declaration of dangerous goods during maritime transportation, T.S. Lines will not only cautiously face and thoroughly assess related risks but also, based on our consistent position of maintaining maritime transportation safety, further enhance the supervision of the declaration of dangerous goods. This is to reduce the incidences of concealment, non-declaration, and incorrect declaration and thereby lower the associated risks. For customers who fail to comply with declaration regulations by concealing, non-declaring, or incorrectly declaring the names or hazardous levels of goods within export containers, our company will not only seek compensation for all damages and costs incurred but will also impose fines under the following circumstances:

- Any actual dangerous goods not declared as such
- Any actual dangerous goods declared as non-dangerous goods
- Concealment, non-declaration, and incorrect declaration of the hazardous level and UN number of dangerous goods

The specific fines and regulations are as follows:

Charge Item	Amount	Charging Basis Unit
Fine	USD 20,000	Per container containing concealed or incorrectly declared dangerous goods
Additional Operation and Handling Fees	Based on the actual operational costs	
related handling	fees incurred	Per container containing concealed or incorrectly declared dangerous goods
